Good afternoon CASC,

I attended the November RSC held 11/16 in Haddonfield, NJ. All 12 areas of the NJ Region were represented. Seven motions were voted on; 5 which were carried, 1 failed and 1 tabled back to the maker. There are no motions which need to be brought back to Areas at this time.

One topic discussed at length was the analysis of "Fair Share" costs per Area for Insurance, Helpline and Website. Insurance cost is based on the number of in-person meetings each Area has, and Helpline and Website cost is based on total meetings per Area. **The Fair Share analysis is for informational purposes only – it does not mandate any payment.** The NJRSC has us listed as having 21 in-person groups, however our November minutes state that we have 20 groups. If the Area can clarify how many meetings we have and which are designated as in-person, hybrid and online only, I can forward that updated information to the Region.

Again, the "Fair Share Analysis does not mandate payment/donation to the Region, it is something that RCM's and Areas asked to have provided for informational purposes. After attending my first NJRSC, I see that some Areas do utilize the "Fair Share" costs as a guideline when considering their donation to the Region. For reference, The Capital Area "Fair Share" breaks down to \$90.99 at the time this Analysis was performed. If the Area wanted to donate to cover our "Fair Share" costs at each RSC, this would be the amount.

MARLCNA XL is being held **January 17-19, 2025**. I am not sure of the Area's policy on sending the RCM to MARLCNA but the current hotel room rates are only valid until **12/29/24**. Registration fees for the convention also increase after **12/17/24**. I will paste the links here with information for registration.
